NATURE OF WORK

Maintains solid waste landfill operations by operating heavy equipment and performing general maintenance of the heavy equipment.

Competing demands include occasional overtime and dealing with external customers in a courteous and respectful manner. **Safety sensitive position subject to drug and alcohol testing according to SCSWA policy.**

Position functions at a solid waste landfill facility with exposure to all types of weather conditions, odors, dust, heavy metals, asbestos particles and fumes and the possibility of minor cuts and bruises. Safety shoes and glasses are required. Position requires substantial physical ability to operate heavy equipment; bend, stoop, climb, crouch, kneel, squat, push/pull and reach above shoulder level. Writing and use of standard hand tools. Ability to lift, carry and push/pull items weighing up to 70 pounds. Field of vision and visual acuity is necessary to perform essential functions.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operates various types of heavy mobile equipment, which includes water wagon, dump truck compactors, loaders and other heavy equipment for landfill operation
- Performs preventive maintenance and minor repairs on equipment and identifies maintenance needed to be performed by mechanic.
- Assists crew members in other functions when not operating equipment
- Performs other job-related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Equivalent to a high school diploma or GED. Two (2) years of experience operating heavy construction equipment is required. A valid NM driver's license. A combination of education, experience and training may be applied in accordance with SCSWA policy.

KNOWLEDGE SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Basic reading and writing abilities. Ability to interact respectfully with Authority staff and the general public. Intermediate arithmetic abilities, including linear, square, and cubic measurements. Ability to perform repetitive, short-cycle work and attain precise standards.

ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS: Position functions 100% outside and is exposed to all types of weather conditions, noise, fumes, dust, dirt. Safety shoes required at all times.

PHYSICAL FACTORS: Requires moderate physical effort including frequent balancing, bending and stooping, crouching, kneeling and constant climbing. Ability to lift 50 pounds from the floor involving items such as: grates and sandbags. Ability to communicate via two-way communication device and must be alert to traffic hazards. Requires writing and use of standard hand tools frequently during each shift.

WORK SITUATION FACTORS: Position requires working extended hours, shift work, and on call status. safety sensitive position and requires **RANDOM DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING.**
